Sub: Advertisement for Engaging Teachers on Contract Basis, in AEC Schools/ Junior College, Anushaktinagar, Mumbai for the Academic year 2026-27

It is proposed to conduct a Skill test / a Demo Teaching class for engaging teachers on contract basis against the leave / regular vacancies that may arise during the Academic Year 2026-27. The details of post, pay, eligibility criterion and minimum and maximum age limits are given below.

I. Educational and other qualification for the Trained Graduate Teacher (TGT) Post

- Three years Bachelor's Degree from a recognized University with at least 50% marks in aggregate by which Degree is awarded by the University or equivalent CGPA (obtained by conversion to percentage in accordance with the method of conversion of corresponding University's/institution's norms) in the respective subject (Refer Table-1).

OR

Four years integrated degree course – B.A.Ed. from Regional College of Education of NCERT/ from any National Council for Teacher Education recognized institution with at least 50% marks in aggregate by which Degree is awarded by the University or equivalent CGPA (obtained by conversion to percentage in accordance with the method of conversion of corresponding University's /institution's norms) in the respective subject.

2. (a) B.Ed. or equivalent degree from any recognized University /Institute.
(b) B.Ed. is not required for the candidates with B.A.Ed. or M.A. Ed.
3. Qualified in Paper-II of Central Teacher Eligibility Test (CTET) conducted by the CBSE in accordance with the guidelines framed by the NCTE for the purpose.
4. Proficiency in teaching in English medium.
5. Teaching qualification (2 and 3) is not mandatory for the Post of TGT (PET).

Note: Candidates without B.Ed. and CTET can also apply if they have secured 55% and above marks (for Humanities Subjects) in the Graduation level.

IV. Candidates without teaching qualification (B.Ed., D.El.Ed, B.EL.Ed, CTET) can also apply and will be empanelled separately on selection.

V. Mode of Selection

- (a) A skill test / a Demo Teaching Class will be conducted and the selected candidates will be empanelled and recruited in the order of merit.
(b) Performance of the candidates will be assessed based on presentation by the candidates **on two topics, one chosen by self and other provided by the school** followed by personnel interaction on the subject
- 3 panels will be prepared:
 - Panel I – Candidates with all the requisite qualifications for TGTs, PRT Music and Balvatika teachers separately
 - Panel II – Candidates without CTET score for TGT English
 - Panel III – Candidates without teaching qualification for TGTs and Balvatika teachers separately
- The panels mentioned above will be operated in sequential order viz. in the order of their merit.
- The panel is valid till 31st March 2027
- The contract can be terminated any time during the period of contract, if the performance of the Contract teacher is not found as per the required standards.
- Contract teachers have to follow Conduct Rules prescribed by AEES during the service. Violation of Conduct of Rules can lead to termination of contract.
- The Reporting time for all the candidates is between 10:00 am to 12 Noon on the date of the Skill Test. No candidate will be entertained beyond reporting hours.
- If the number of candidates registered for the Skill Test is more, the number of days for the skill test will be extended accordingly. The information of the candidates called on the next day (if any) will be displayed on the noticeboards at the respective centre.
