## HISTORICAL BACKGROUND OF THE JUNIOR COLLEGE

AEJC, Mumbai was established in 1971, in the pristine environs of Anushaktinagar ensconced in the lap of nature with wooded hills as the landscape. The state-of-the-art structure of AEJC is a spectator's delight and the pride of every AEESian. AEJC comprises of a three-storeyed building, spacious with well-ventilated classrooms, modern laboratories, a treasure house of knowledge for a library and a well-planned auditorium. In 1971, AEJC was started with Science, Commerce and Arts streams under the Central Board of Secondary Education. On popular demand, CBSE was replaced with M.S. Board in 1977 adopting Science and Commerce streams. Vocational Courses were introduced in 1983 comprising of Electrical Maintenance and Electronics. With a good response to the Vocational Courses, Computers was inducted in 1990 and Information Technology in 2000.










## MAKING SOMETHING OUT OF NOTHING-ART COMPETITION






## राजभाषा हिन्दी पखवाडा 2023


